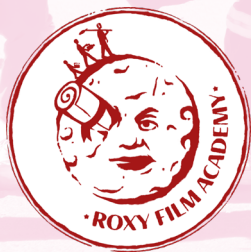

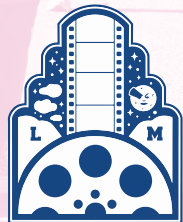

Our role in the community, as the organizers and stewards of the historic Roxy Theater, places the Roxy staff in a privileged position to construct this particular exchange. The act of curating, booking, promoting, and screening films every night at the Roxy endorses the simple yet revolutionary act of movie-going – an engaged and deliberate activity where, as members of our community, we commit to the tradition of cinema, which ultimately is a tradition of being together.

Throughout this last year, we had so many wonderful opportunities to be together. We witnessed some amazing moments at the Roxy, from the summer’s twin cultural milestones BARBIE and OPPENHEIMER, to the meteoric rise of our friend and erstwhile coworker Lily Gladstone, whose breakout performance in KILLERS OF THE FLOWER MOON earned her a historic and much-deserved Oscar™ nomination. We celebrated 10 years as Missoula’s Community Cinema in 2023, a landmark occasion. We welcomed guests from around the world to our four annual film festivals. And we organized our largest and most successful summer filmmaking camp for area students, this year introducing a very welcome high school program for the Roxy Film Academy.

Events and programs like these bring together community members to gather, share, and grow. They bring many Missoulians to the Roxy for the first time. Most importantly, they put people into a truer relationship with cinema: watching movies in a theater, where they belong.
